Healthy Community

One in five Napa County residents depends on OLE Health as their primary source of wellness services. OLE Health is the largest single recipient of Auction Napa Valley funding and Napa County's only nonprofit health clinic, providing comprehensive care for those who need it.

- Our investments in community health agencies provide care for clients from birth to hospice, encompassing a wide range of physical and mental health services.
- 205,000 patient visits or treatment sessions over the past year helped
 60,000 clients manage chronic illness, overcome mental health issues or receive preventative services.
- 8,040 care providers received training to detect, treat or prevent illness and injury.

Children's Education

English language learners who participated in the Napa Valley Early Learning Initiative were three times more likely to be fully ready for kindergarten. Research indicates that kindergarten readiness is a strong marker for future success in school and in life and that narrowing the educational achievement gap helps all children succeed.

- From early childhood education to college access and support, our nonprofit partners provide in-classroom and out-ofclassroom enrichment, mentoring, character development and access to technology.
- 30,000 students were given tools to help them succeed in school and in life and our investments in training 520 teachers will help them provide children with necessary skills for the 21st century.
- 1,800 youth demonstrated improved healthy behaviors and 3,500 enhanced their academic skills due to mentorship, homework help and other support programs.

Family Engagement

Triple P (Positive Parenting Program) is an evidence-based program which promotes healthy and safe families by improving parenting skills, parent confidence, resiliency, coping skills and reducing stress. Cope Family Center now leads a countywide collaboration of local agencies disseminating Triple P throughout Napa County.

More Than Bricks and Sticks

These recent investments in capital projects will ensure that more children have a safe and positive place for out of school time and that there is a low cost medical home for all who need it.

- An unprecedented \$6 million grant toward construction of the new OLE Health South Napa Campus, expected to serve more than 15,000 patients annually. The 30,000 square-foot medical facility will offer a dynamic menu of services in the areas of primary care, behavioral health, dental, optometry, nutrition and more.
- A pledge of \$2 million to construct a new 14,000-square-foot clubhouse for the Boys & Girls Club of American Canyon. The facility is expected to serve 250-300 children each day and will feature areas dedicated to early childhood education, teens and technology.
- A \$2 million grant to build a new 14,000square-foot Boys & Girls Clubs of St. Helena and Calistoga clubhouse and community center in Calistoga with classroom space, technology and art labs, a commercial kitchen and a multi-purpose gymnasium.
